We are teaming up with the “Meals of Hope” organization and the Salvation Army to help feed the hungry in our community.

Currently we are in the process of collecting donations to pay for the supplies and ingredients.

The intention is to host the event at HCC on Saturday July 16 from 10am-12pm. Breakfast will be served for event volunteers from 9-10am.

Here’s how this works...

- One event will package 10,000 meals.
- Volunteers fill bags with the ingredients, seal and pack in boxes.
- It’s an opportunity for fellowship while serving.

The Salvation Army can use the packages:

- to prepare a hot meal for those in need and
- they can also hand out the meals from their pantry.

HCC will retain a supply of meals for distribution.
